Even a king has to travel to settle the affairs of state and return when certain wrongs are made right.

Baby and I are fine and still in good spirits. Helma and Joel are well and I expect to see them to-morrow and Saturday the remainder of the family will spend the day

with us. I'm preparing a tongue, potatoe salad, cole slaw
and the trimmings with all their assistance. You'll be with
us in spirit, fear not my darling, and I have your pictures
in every room just as a reminder that George is still around,
my favorite fix up boy.

The car runs O.K. - I bought that bond in Dec. - all
