Resolved That it be recommended to the force the States as indespensibly need any that they reft a force in brought to leave for the use of Minited thates a duty of five per unt an andorem at the time and place of importation upon all goods, wares and muchan izes of forcign growth and manufactures which may be imported into any of the said thates from any forcign port island or plantation after the first day of May 1781 except arms ammunition cloathing and other articly insported on account of the United States or any of them: and except wool card, and letton early and write for making them and also except salt during the war.
