Abstract	This collection is made up about 1200 pieces of correspondence and other materials including photo negatives, newspapers, pamphlets, military orders, etc. Correspondence and paper materials have a date range from 1937 to 1945.

Scope and Contents note

The collection is made up of correspondences and other materials, most of these materials were mailed along with the correspondence or are relevant to the Stoff Family during this time period

The majority of the correspondence is between George Stoff and Florence Stoff, husband and wife who were separated after George was drafted into the military during World War II. There are other correspondence with George's family including his brother Robert Stoff and his Mom and Pop. There is also correspondence with Eleanor Prosterman, Florence's sister. Other correspondence includes Dan Eidler and Max Pincus.

Other materials include unused postcards, photograph negatives, newspapers, pamphlets, military orders, etc.
