

New Hampton September 4th 1762

Sir
I would inform you that I find the Paper
that I now send by Lieut Thompson -
It was brought into this Town by one M^r
Mansey of N. Holderness and left at M^r
Boynston's - M^r Mansey earnestly requested
M^r Boynston (as I understand) to send one
of his sons to me desiring me to meet him on
Wednesday Next at Concord - - I confess I
do not know the Meaning of the Matter I
should be glad if you would be so good as to in-
form me what you think of the Matter in
writing by Lieut Thompson as he is coming
here a Monday Morning - - - -

I had some thoughts of going to Concord to -
see the Gen^l Court one Day next week.
