It was such a good feeling to learn that you and Jim are in excellent health and spirits these days. I am so pleased the folks visited you and do hope they manage to be so frequently. I'm sure you will not find them too much trouble. I do not understand why they have not received any mail in two weeks, since I write them every third day. Please check with them and advise whether or not they do not receive letters from me dated that way. Now that the mail has begun to come through I suppose all the back mail will catch up with me in a day or two. The above letters were the only ones I received to. day.
