## Biographical/Historical note

Donald Wellman was born in Nashua, New Hampshire and attended the University of New Hampshire and received his Doctor of Arts with concentrations in Old and Middle English, and Modern Literature from the University of Oregon. He has taught previously in St. Croix USVI, Cambridge, Lowell, and Boston, MA, Cranberry Isles, ME and was a long time Professor at Daniel Webster College since 1984, recently appointed to Professor Emeritus status in 2013.

In 1981 Dr. Wellman founded O.ARS, a literary and cultural organization, publishing anthologies or poetry, visual poetry, experimental prose, and commentary. He served as Director until 1995. Dr. Wellman has also published a number of literary works including a book of poetry which spanned twenty years of his work entitled Fields, which was released in 1995. He has also published a number of conference papers and criticism on key modernist figures.
