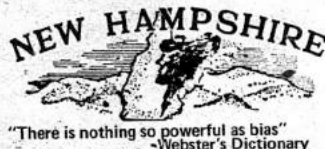

Horse Disease Spread By Sex

Gov. Tomson Bans Pants On Women

Tomson's Horses Raped

OXFORD-In a vile, brazen and politically motivated act eight of Gov. Meldrim Tomson's prize farm horses were brutally raped last night at the governor's Mt. Cube Farm in Oxford.

Three large donkeys were arrested and taken into custody this morning by state police. The asses were picked up after being found loitering in a nearby meadow.

Gov. Tomson was in session with the Executive Council when he was informed. He rushed to the side of the mastered mares under heavy police guard.

Three of the mares were unable to walk this morning, while the other five were reportedly much more active than usual.

"The Democrats will pay for this foul, disgusting travesty of justice. Their cheap, low-down tactics have always been offensive but this is a new low. I will not stop until their kind of scam is driven out of the Granite State," said Tomson.

The governor ordered a 24 hour guard put on his barn and announced that he was taking money from the state's emergency contingency fund to aid the three injured mares.

Leader publisher Wil-

helm Lowebb issued a statement expressing "sympathy to the governor and Mrs. Tomson and all the bereaved at Mt. Cube farm. Be assured that the thoughts and prayers of Granite State citizens are with the stricken in their time of need."

Tomson said that although he genuinely understood the mare's predicament, it was not within the confines of

his moral conscience to allow "loose animals" on his farm.

"Thus it is with regret that I have ordered the eight mares who succumbed to temptation to be slaughtered at dawn," said Tomson.

The governor used the occasion to release a plea for the reinstatement of capital punishment for violent crimes. "These animals should have their throats torn out," he said.

Lobster War Honored

PORTSMOUTH-Gov. Meldrim Tomson denied that he had compared himself to Christ in popularity and Napoleon in leadership at a banquet for Lobster War veterans last night.

The banquet was held to commemorate the first anniversary of the notorious dispute of fishing rights last April in which 80 Maine fishermen and 120 New Hampshire fishermen died in three battles off the Maine-New Hampshire coast.

The battles included the Battle of Portsmouth, the Battle of York Harbor and the famous Battle of Kittery Point in which

Governor Tomson personally commandeered a U.S. destroyer from the naval shipyard in Portsmouth and blew 24 dinghies and 13 lobster vessels out of the water.

Unfortunately, Tomson then ran the destroyer around while attempting to navigate the Piscataqua River. All the crew was lost except for Tomson who was rescued by a state police helicopter.

"I never compared myself in popularity to Christ," said Tomson as he launched into an attack on the former rock group, the Beatles.

"I never compared myself in leadership to Napoleon," he continued. "Only in stature."

DURHAM-Gov. Meldrim Tomson viewed the charred and smouldering remains of the small coastal town of Durham by helicopter yesterday after ordering that a 20 megaton atomic bomb be dropped here last week.

Tomson contended that the population had unknowingly eaten "poisonous Maine lobsters whose infectious and poisonous rheum attacked the nervous system and spread like wildfire."

Tomson said that, while regrettable, the action must be taken before the rheum disease spread all over the state. He said it was obviously a foul plot perpetrated by Maine lobster fishermen to over New Hampshire's victory in the Lobster War last year.

Tomson said he first began to suspect the devastating effects of the lobster on the nervous system first month when Durham residents "went berserk" and voted down the world's largest oil refinery which was to be built by Aristotle Onassis, Greek shipping magnate.

Tomson denied reports that he had tried to "kill two birds with one stone" by wiping out rebellious Durham and destroying the University of New Hampshire, whose activities and leadership he has often disagreed with, as well.

The governor praised head selectman Alden Winn and UNH president Dr. Thomas Bonner for "the gallant manner in which they went down with their ships."

Also lost in the holocaust were 4,000 Durham residents and 10,000 students.

Of the UNH administration and faculty Tomson said "they were 400 of the finest public servants I have ever had the pleasure of working with. May they rest in peace."

The University trustees, who were holding a meeting when the bomb hit, were all lost, except for Trustee Alan Brille who happened to be out of the state attending an FBI seminar entitled "How to Detect Perverts."

"Well, I guess that relieves the capital budget of the new building expenditures this year," added Tomson, saying that while many parents had lost a son or daughter, they had gained some hard cash when it would really come in handy."

Tomson said the area would be cleared and a living memorial to those who gave their lives that New Hampshire might prosper.

Onassis and his wife Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis (who Onion Loader publisher Wilhelm Lowebb said put on the most convincing mourner's act he had ever seen at her late husband's funeral) are among the dignitaries who will be attending next week combination memorial and ground breaking ceremonies if the nuclear fallout has cleared by then.

Rodfern Resigns

KEENE—Leo F. Rodfern has resigned as KSC President from a refugee camp in Vermont.

"Thank God he's gone," acting President Porky Jackson, an American Legionnaire, said. "We've had a belly-full of that man."

Jackson, speaking at the Island Bar on Church Street Friday night, said that it would now be possible for the Legion to go on campus and "clean up."

"We're sick of the blatant immorality and sex going on over there," he said. "If there's anything over there that even looks

like it's capable of sex, we're gonna boil them in beer and feed them to the goddamn planks at the Keene Sentinel, Equinox, and school board."

While stating that he didn't want the job as President, Jackson said that he would insist on "a man of character" to take Rodfern's place.

"Right now, we've got feelers out to Rudolf Hess, Spiro Agnew, and the skate sharpener of the Philadelphia Flyers," he said. "But what the hell, when we get done cleaning up the campus there might not even be any students."

State To Become Disneyland

Governor Meldrim Tomson has sold Keene State College to Disneyland World Corporation, a course close to Tomson said yesterday.

"The transaction has already been completed," the unidentified link told an Onion Loader reporter on the phone. "KSC is on the verge of becoming a Mickey Mouse operation."

California, and will take about three years to build. The spokesman said that the ROCKS storage shed would probably be converted for this purpose.

The recent extermination of the University of New Hampshire and the sale of KSC leaves New Hampshire with one public college—Plymouth State.

College Buys Pig Troughs

The administration might experiment with a new food serving method next year, as part of Keene State's 1974 economy drive.

"We recently purchased 140 troughs from a farmer who lost all his pigs in an epidemic of sortie animism," Director of Physical Plant Robert L. Mallat said. "We hope to install these troughs in all the dormitory rest rooms by the Fall semester."

Mallat said that students would be served leftovers from execu-

tive luncheons combined with paint chips from the Waltz Lecture Hall ceiling.

"We will save the most money in silverware and plates," Mallat stated. "Also, we will no longer have to hire kitchen assistance, since all food preparation will be done by the Science Building janitors."

Mallat said that the money saved would be used for administrative pay raises and a scaffold to convert the Dining Commons into a faculty-administration bowling alley.

A-2 Program Proposed For KSC

Keene State student Pasquale Kaputo Jr. will propose an alternative form of student government at next week's Student Senate meeting, Kaputo told a Leader reporter yesterday.

"I'm tired of putting up with this half-assed unrepresentative form of government that we have now," Kaputo said. "It's time for the average student—the one you meet on the street, but never read about in the papers—to have his say."

According to Kaputo, his proposal would call for a 20 member Student Council.
