 I do hope to write often to you.

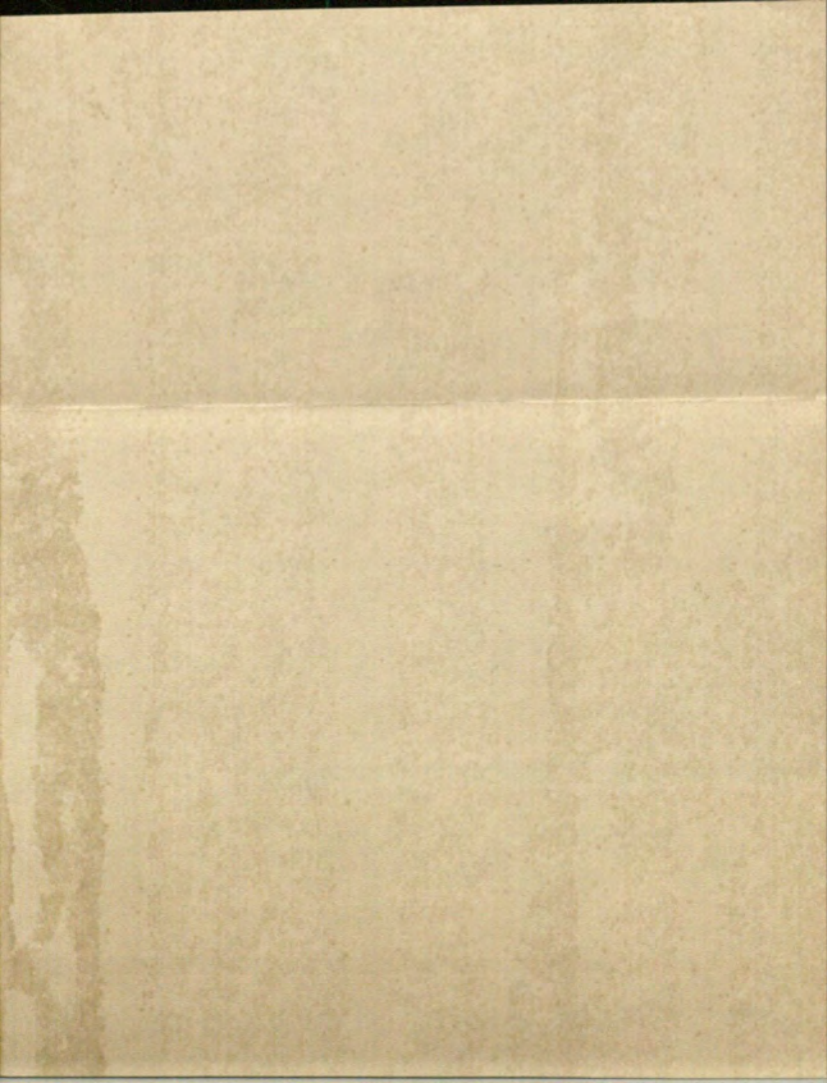
We're now in the town of Monticello and in a
