Owl Lacrosse team off to good start

If it's points that Keene State College Lacrosse Coach Jim Draper wants, then he certainly has his wish. Draper's team has outscored their opponents 58-19 in the first four games of the season, and have compiled a 3-1 record.

Points were of no short supply Saturday at Owl Stadium, as the Keene State Laxters scored five unanswered goals in the first quarter on their way to 16-2 demolition of Green Mountain College.

The Owl Laxters dominated turf play with timely passing, and took advantage of a slower Green Mountain team.

The team used its fast-break, run-and-gun style of offense to take Green Mountain out of the game early. Much of this has to do with the defense, as the Owls boast a strong midfield line and defense that is tenacious.

This year's team looks much better than last season, when the squad went a disappointing 5-6. The improvement of team play is a big reason for the fast start this season. "We are much more of a team this year," said Draper. "We are starting to play together rather than trying to have one or two players dominate the game."

Draper cites the return of Mark Chilicki, Joe Devellis, and Jon Shinault from last year as major factors in the team's success.

"We have real leaders in our captains," he said. "That makes a huge difference."

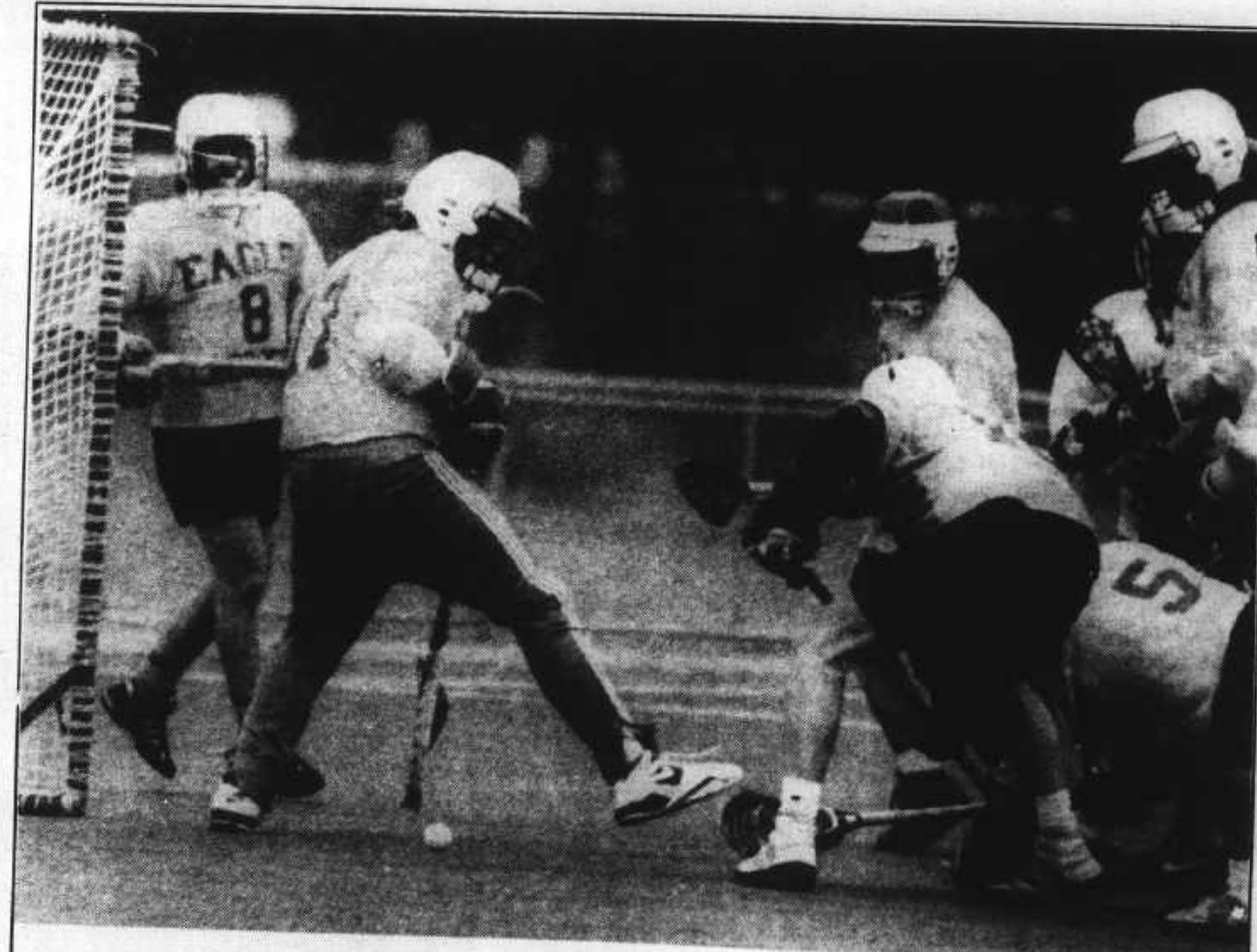
The scores from the games this season are testament to the control that the team has had so far in the year. Colby-Sawyer went down, 17-2, Westfield was beaten Wednesday night, 15-4, and then Green Mountain lost, 16-2. The only loss so far was the first game against Boston University, which was an 11-10

overtime decision.

Draper had some concern for the team's play before the season, because of the unusually cold weather that has been present in the recent weeks.

"We have practiced on the turf for four very cold weeks and it is good to see us start winning so quickly," said Draper. "With four games behind us, the real tests lay ahead; but if we continue to work as a team, we could do very well this season."

The Owls' next game is tonight against St. Anselm at home beginning at 7:00 p.m.

Owl Baseball is put on hold because of wet weather

The winter doesn't seem to want to leave this year, and it has put many spring sports on hold for a while. Keene State College is no exception, as the baseball team has yet to play a game since returning from Florida over two weeks ago.

Keene State isn't the only school to postpone games, as all New England Collegiate Conference schools have had to reschedule games that were supposed to be played. Keene State College Assistant Baseball Coach Pat Hearn was optimistic about playing before Saturday, but the weekend snow, mud, and rain quelled any hopes of a game. A total of eight games have been postponed.

Keene State has played games during snow flurries in the past, but this season has been too severe to even go on the field.

Weather isn't the only factor working against the team, as the

shortened semester has caused the entire schedule to move an entire week back. This is the first time that the team has had to cut back games because of semester shortening.

The NECC may move the date for all games to be completed to May 11, but nothing is definite yet.

In spite of the weather, practices still continue in the gymnasium, beginning at 6:30 a.m. and ending around 8 a.m. The practices are becoming frustrating for the players, for it keeps them off of real grass where they really need to practice.

"You can only take so many ground balls on a hard floor," said second baseman Keith Hobby.

Today's game against Assumption College has also been moved, and forces Keene State to pack even more games into what was already a crammed schedule. The next game is tentatively scheduled for Thursday at 2 p.m. against Plymouth State at home.

New building to be erected

Condom shaped Student Center will promote AIDS awareness at KSC

Years of planning for the new Student Union have been scrapped in favor of a new plan that was inspired by AIDS awareness.

The new plan calls for a 15 story building shaped like a condom. This landmark building will be the largest in the Monadnock region of the Connecticut River Valley. The student union will be fully erect by the fall of 1994.

There is stiff competition between vendors—Marriot Corporation, Service America, ARA, and SAG—for use of "The Recepticle End," a rotating cafe on the top floor. The Recepticle End will be enclosed in glass to provide panoramic and exhilarating views of the region.

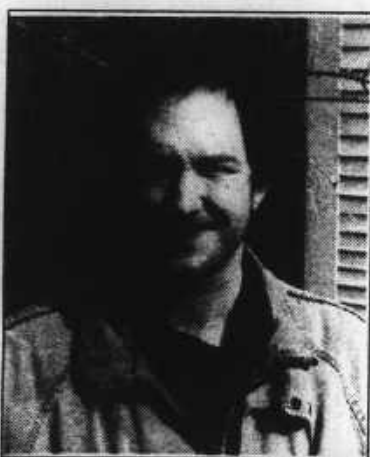

Toth, the president of the New Hampshire Chapter of American Atheists, has been tapped as the early favorite by the national media, simply because he's been annoying Keene State and the local community the longest.

An outspoken critic of the college's relationship with God—the big one has an office in Hale building after all—Toth is in a legal battle to blow up the Newman Center and campus ministry.

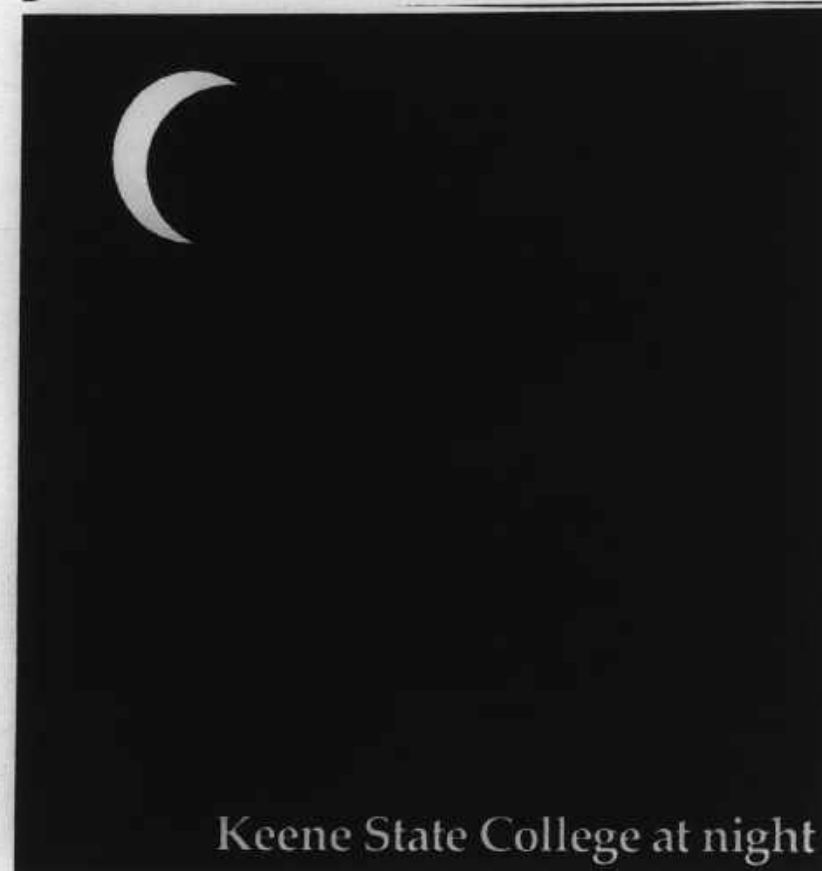

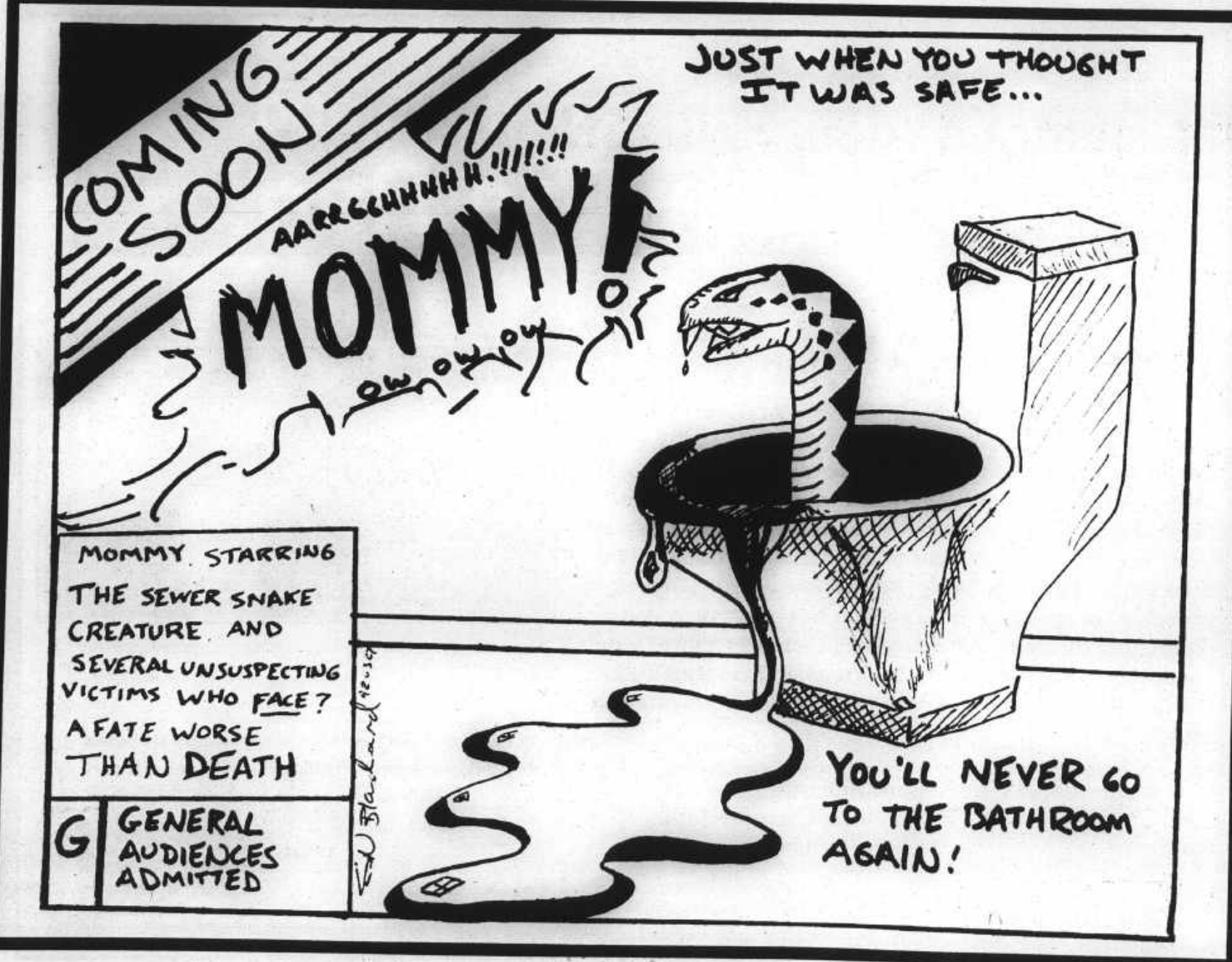

During the middle of an economic recession the student leaders of Kinda Sorta College voted unanimously to give themselves a raise.

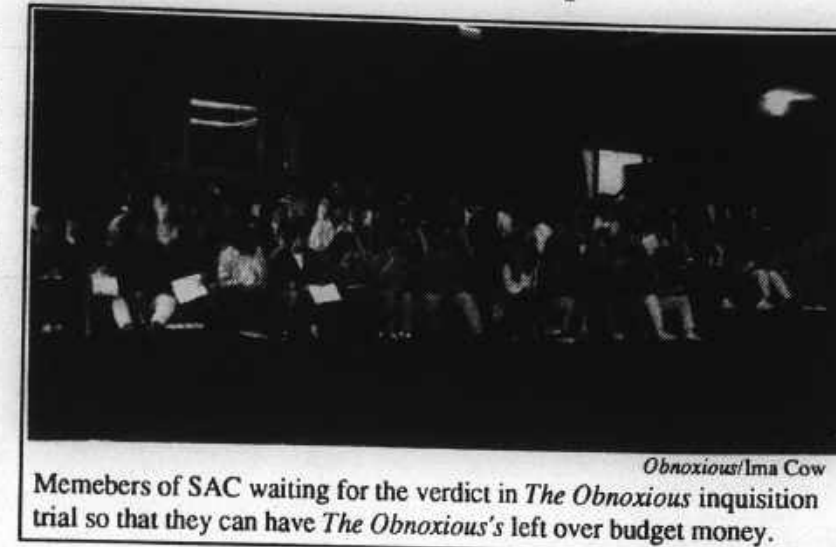

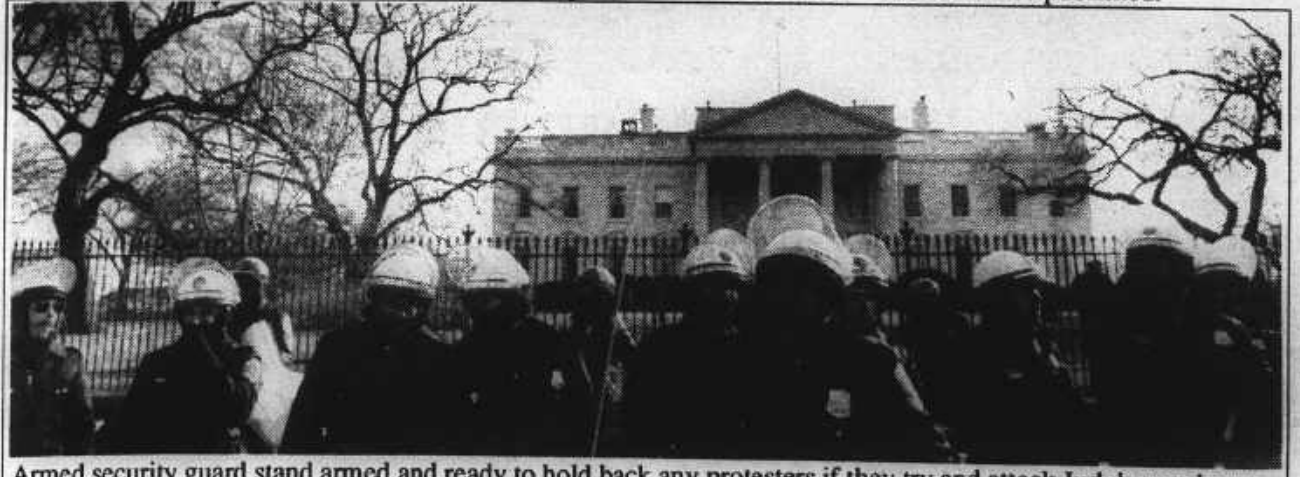
When asked about the remaining 5% of oxygen that was not accounted for, Bruce was quoted as saying, "So I rounded off. Sue me!"

WASHINGTON — On Saturday night, at just about nine, 47 individuals boarded bus number 1427 and headed south along Route 10. Destination: Washington D.C. The rest, we hope, will go down in history.

The trip coordinators, Dana DeMille and Elizabeth Darlington, organized the pilgrimage to the nation's capital during the last few months. Both have been long-time believers in pro-choice.

"A lot of people think that it won't affect them, but when millions of women start dying because people are going in the back alley and having illegal abortions, it's going to affect them," DeMille said. "I think there are going to be a lot of people there who are concerned and it's real, Roe v. Wade, there's a big possibility it's going to get turned over and that's why we need to go."

1:00 a.m. Somewhere along Interstate 95 in New Jersey. We stretched our legs and said hello to the folks in the National Organization of Women (NOW) bus who were also headed to the march.

7:15 a.m. The Pentagon. A rising sun welcomed us into Washington, and as we boarded the Metro towards the Capitol, it was easy to see we would be joined by hundreds of thousands of marchers from across the
