Honourable

It comes with my regards and Duty to
your Honour, and the Honourable Committee of Safety, Hoping
they will find your Honours well, as they now leave me, also Officers
and Soldiers is the same, this is my third Letter to your honours,
but I received no answer as yet, it would be a great pleasure to me to hear
from your honours, and of your welfare, for I am a man that never forg-
ets past Favours, which I received from your honours, I obtained
Liberty from General Gates and General Starks to go and see
my Men in their different Departments, where their Stationed
Captains Punnett is at Fiverton, in plain sight of the Enemy
and their Incampments, Captain Emerson is about a mile and
half from Captain Punnett, and part of the Men at Warren, I was
at all the Departments, and returned here last week, if our men
was all come into Join, our men would be all Stationed at Warren
what hinders our Men, being in one Incampment, is the very Cause
of our men not coming into Join our Regiment, this Day had
Liberty obtained from General Gates, and General Starks, for my
going to warran, to Join my Men there, if I can find an Officer
to leave here that I can depend on to take care of the Men as they come
in here, but I see no Encouragement of my more coming in, there is
but five come into Camps this fortnight past, your honours will
see by my Returns here Inclosed, how many men is wanting
to complete the Regiment, and what Militia Regiments have
not sent their Men, the General much wonder what makes
New Hampshire so backward this year for they used to be
the best State in sending their men in season, the General has
been Obliged to call in the Militia from the Bay late for
four Weeks, our Army being so few in Number, so I hope your honours
will take under your Consideration, and send what Number of men
is

mending one Adams of Londonderry for an Ensign and Adjutant, I can
wish he was here, and also a Surgeon is wanting please to send a Blank
to file for a Lieut, and a Blank to file for an Ensign, the Lieut. Spence
to file for Captain Kelley, he has done that Duty for Lieut. ever since
he was here, and is a very good man, also please to send me a Copy
of the vote of the Honourable General Court of N. Hampshire, how
long the Soldiers is to serve after they are in the Army, it may prevent
Disputes that may arise with the men when their time is almost out,
General Stark desires me when I write to your honours at any time,
to give his Compliments to the Honourable Committee of Safety,
Major Pinnals will let you know what news is amongst us here
