After riding about two hours we came to a town called Tunkhannock; where we decided it would be a good time^{place} for me to learn to drive.

We chose a quiet, secluded square block; never considering or feeling the impending doom. I had driven around this block perhaps thirty times (at a snail pace) when someone gave me the horn.
