and we even managed to bid a little.

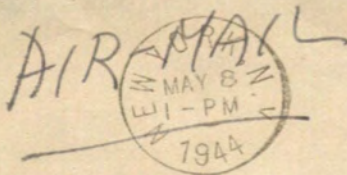
The dinner was good but would have
