But don't worry - I'm taking care of my cold and drinking plenty of warm milk. The needles are getting me lonely.

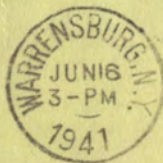
Take care of yourself, my love, and I'll take good care of me.
