Only in the United States, I guess, can these

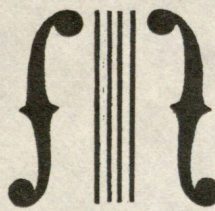

I have decided that my address will definitely be —

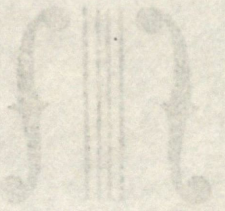
