legally called and convened on the 9th Day
of February 1778 Unanimously Voted to accept and approve
of the articles of Confederation and perpetual Union
offered by the Continental Congress

Likewise Voted a Committee to give Instructions to our
Representative from time to time and in Portokal the
taking up a new Plan of Government which we think is
necessary to be speedily done, a true Copy from the minutes
of said meeting by order of the Moderator J^r D. Starrel J. Clerk
Dated at Derryfield this 9th of February 1778

Derryfield February the 9 1778
this may Certify that we the Superscribers a Committee Chosen
on said Day in ord to Give Instructions to your honour
as you are our Representative Concerning forming a new
Plan of Government, and as we are not thorelly acquainted with
the plan of Government that the General Cort is upon we
Desire that your honour Would make Report to us as soon
as may be in order that we may Consult and Give further
