Biographical/Historical note

Rodger Martin was born in the Amish country of Pennsylvania, lived in England as a child, and served as a combat engineer in Vietnam. He was the managing editor of The Worcester Review for 26 years and helped found and direct the New Hampshire's Poetry Out Loud program. Martin received his BS in Education from Millersville State University and his Masters in Education from Keene State College.

Martin currently teaches Journalism at Keene State College and advises the college newspaper, The Equinox. He is the co-editor of the Hobblebush Books Granite State Poetry Series. Martin has received an Appalachia poetry award, a N.H. Council on the Arts Fiction Fellowship, the Bruce Kellner/Monadnock Fellowship, and fellowships from The National Endowment for the Humanities.

Martin has published four books: The Battlefield Guide (Hobblebush Books, 2010), The Blue Moon Series (Hobblebush Books, 2007), Gettysburg (Lewis, 2000), and The Nemo Poems (Goosebrook, 1992). He has also published work in multiple journals, including: Amoskeag, Appalachia, Entelechy, Granite Review, Poetry South, and The Chrysalis Reader.
