Sof up and down in his crib.

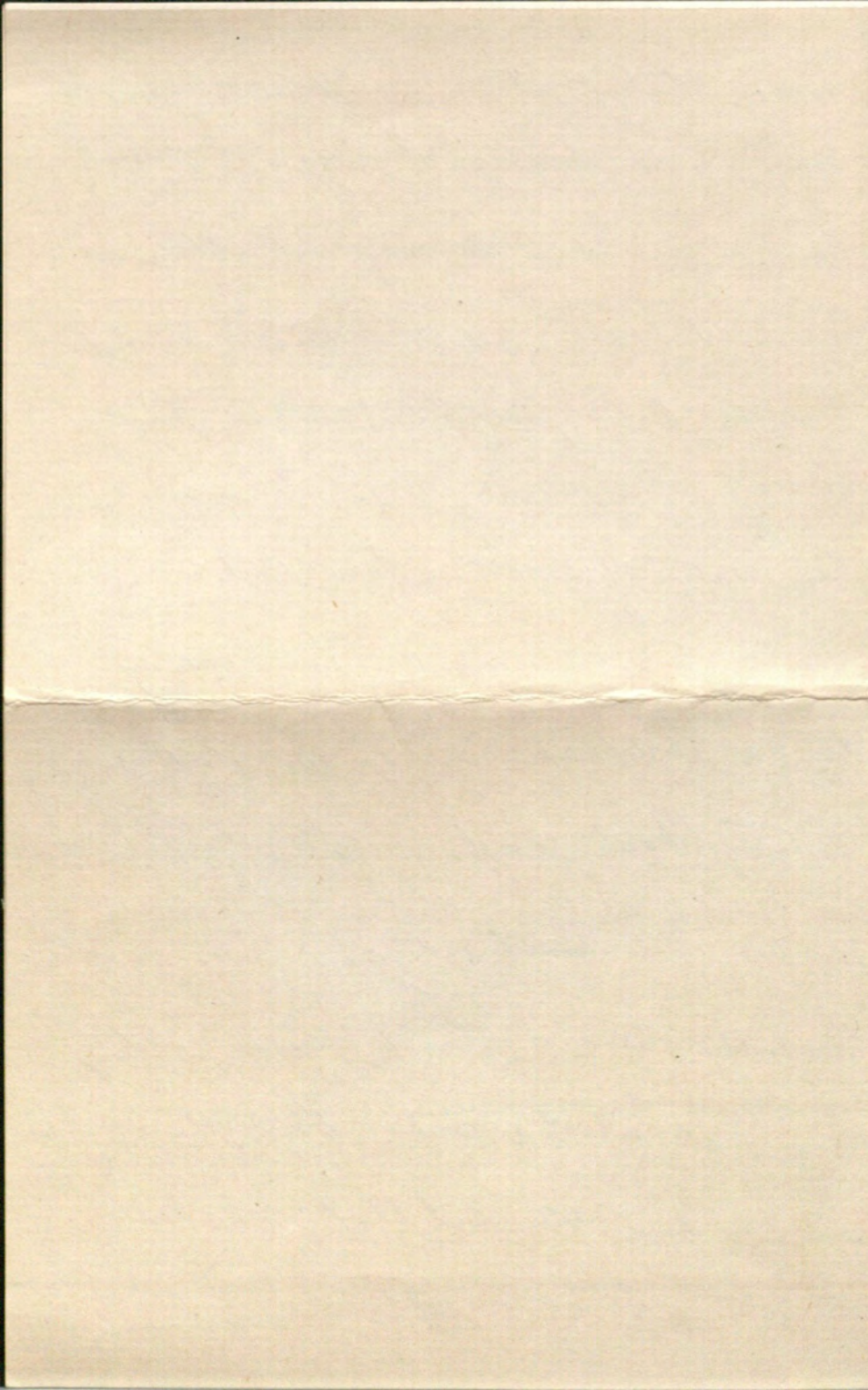
A few-calls to day from the family and all is well on the home front. Regards from all.

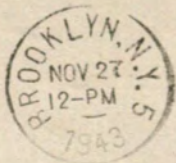
Hope this finds you not too lonesome and in good health and spirits. Mom and Pop send their love.
