Whereas Abigail Hackett Spinster a Single
Woman is Lately Come to Reside or Dwell in
the Parish of Hampton falls aforesaid she not
Having Gained a Legal Settlement therein But hath by
Order of the Select Men of said Parish been Duely Warned
forthwith to Depart out of Said Parish And a Return of
said Warning hath been made to the Court of Quarter Sessions
of the Peace for the Province aforesaid as the Law Directs.
But yet the Said Abigail Notwithstanding such Warning
given th^o fourteen Days have Elapsed since said Warning
And Return thereof made as aforesaid, Still Neglects
And Refuses to Depart out of said Parish. And Whereas
it Appears that Salisbury in the County of Essex in
the Province of the Massachusetts Bay is the Place of
the Last Legal Settlement of the said Abigail

These are Therefore in his Majestys Name to Require
you forthwith safely to Convey the Said Abigail
Hackett from the Parish of Hampton falls aforesaid
to the Town of Salisbury aforesaid at her own Charge
if she is able. Hereof fail not And make Due Return
Dated at Hampton falls aforesaid the 9th Day of
May Anno Domini 1757 In the 30th Year of his
Majestys Reign &c: —
