(BEEP)....As a matter of fact, it is this difference that will make the crucial difference between the struggle in America today. If you will look at most of the struggling forces, they are spontaneous, not only unorganized but they in fact react to the enemy rather than making the enemy react to them. Here we'll take the peace movement, it's a clear example, they will wait until America go to Vietnam, they come with signs "Get out of Vietnam". They will wiat until America goes to Lebanon and come with signs "Get out of Lebanon". They will wait until America goes to Iraq and they come with signs "Get out of Iraq". They were always waiting for the enemy to provoke them to action. This is not a proper way for people to fight. As a matter of fact, the peace movement in this country must organize itself, become aggressive and understand that you must have a peace army which fights for peace every day of their lives. (clapping) This can only be done by transforming the movement from a spontaneous movement to an organized movement. From a spontaneous movement to a spontaneous movement. An organized movement which is permanent.

It has been over 25 years since Jonathan Daniels has been dead, but people will always meet and people will always talk of him. He will always (BEEP) represent an inspiration to them because he recognized his responsibility. His responsibility is clear, "Justice is indivisible". MArtin Luther King said it so well. He said, "Injustice anywhere is a threat to justice everywhere." Consequently, conscious men and women have a responsibilty anywhere they are seeing injustice to not only fight against it, speak out against it but do something against it. Jonathan Daniels represents this. He represents a human being just like all of us, recognizing that life itself is worthless unless it is used in the process to advance life and the only place you can look to advance life is to fight for justice, to fight against injustice. We encourage you all to be fighters for the people. We encourage you all to be fighters for injustice. We encourage you all to be fighters for humanity and we tell you unless you are fighters for justice, unless you are fughters for the people or unless you're fighters for humanity, you are against justice, against the people and against humanity. You have sterling examples everywhere. There is no reason why you should not come to follow them. The world is moving forward. No force on earth can stop it. Once the people know the truth, they cannot dream of lies. The people know that they must be free. They know they're willing to expend all energies to be free. Heighten struggles by capitalism will not diminish thier will, only intensify their will for freedom. In this process you have but one decision. Either you march with the people for freedom or you are a drag on the people plus against them. We encourage you to come to make a proper contribution to humanity. We encourage you to come to understand that you as a human being came here not as a dog but as a human being and with conscience as a morla regulator have a responsibility to use this moral regulator to take you to higher moral grounds always putting the interests of others above yourself.
