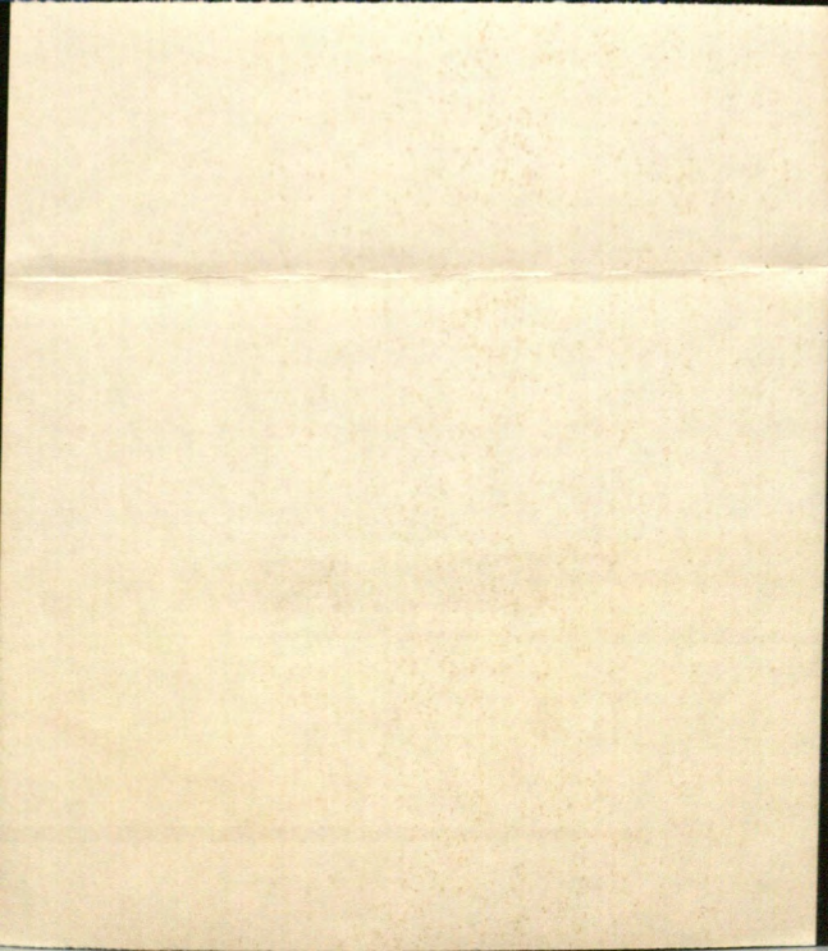
George, dearest,

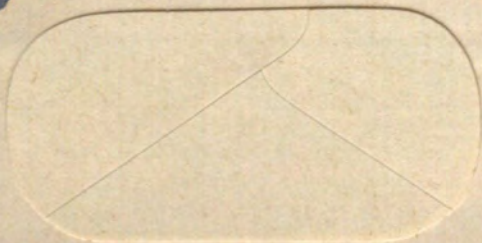
