What in the month of January & 1777 your Petitioner in consequence of Orders Received from the Anthority of this State. mustered Eighteen men from his Regiment which he was Ordered to send of to New york. That about the lime they were to march so deep a Inow fell as rendered it extremely tedious for them to go on their way . There for that the Service may might not Suffer, Sent a man with two Horses and a Sleigh to carry their Jacks which from the enclement Season were need saryly heavy the Distance of One Himbred and Fifty miles from the place of muster on his topenees and your Setitioner Lesires your Honors consideration of the Premises and that you will Allow him a sum adequate to the Service done and your Selitioner as in Duty bound will ever Fray be Benj " Bellows
