All my love to you as always and Jim and I so miss you and love you every moment.

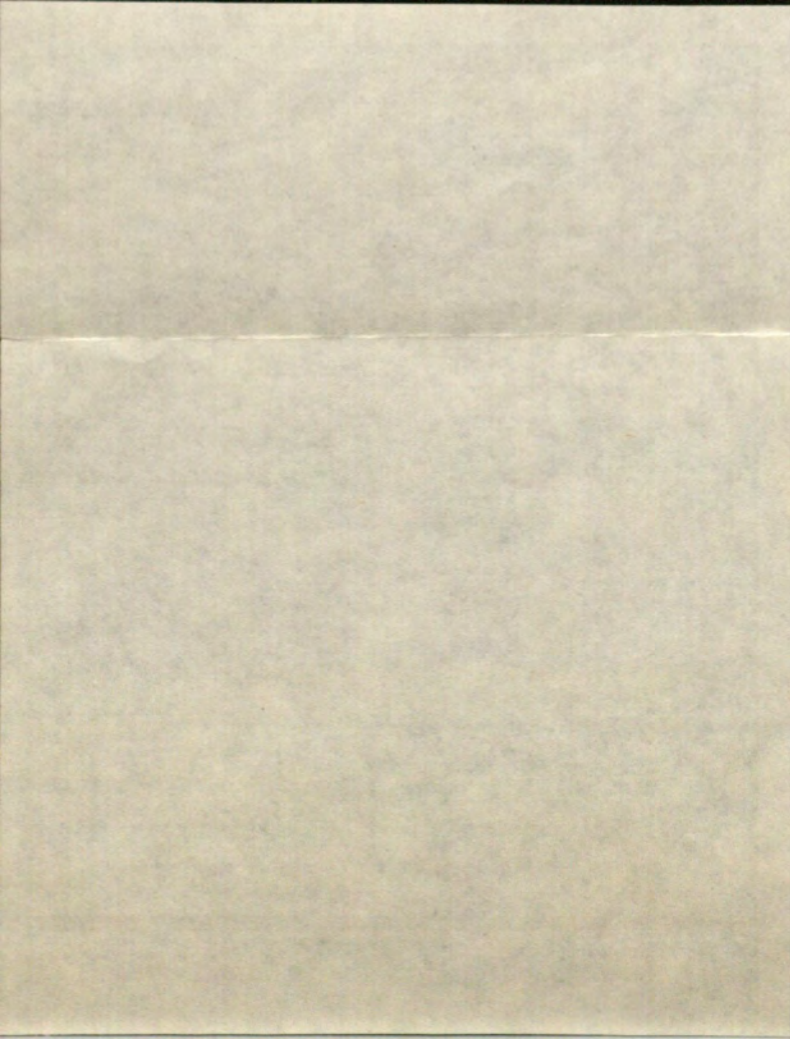
